LPR LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION


- ABLE TO SEE AND RUN PLATES WITHIN SECONDS
- NOTIFIES RTCC WHO THEN NOTIFIES OFFICERS







SHOTSPOTTER



- CAN LOCATE A HIGH PITCH SOUND TO ITS EXACT LOCATION.
- Can notify Officers if the shots are stationary or in motion



WHEN TO CALL 911

- WHEN IN DOUBT CALL 911
- IF SOMETHING IS HAPPENING TO YOU, CALL 911 DO NOT CALL FRIENDS AND FAMILY FIRST.
- IF YOU NEED TO CONTACT THE POLICE, BUT IT IS NOT AN EMERGENCY DIAL 314-231-1212 (ONLY IN ST. LOUIS)

WHAT TO TELL THE DISPATCHER

- ADDRESS FIRST JUST IN CASE YOU GET DISCONNECTED
- Description! Description!
- WHAT THE REASON IS YOUR CALLING
- Recorded lines
- VEHICLE LICENSE PLATE AND STATE, COLOR, MAKE, MODEL, ANY BUMPER STICKERS, THINGS HANGING FROM THE REAR VIEW MIRROR, WINDOW TINTS, THINGS MISSING OR BROKEN
- PERSON HEIGHT, WEIGHT (APPROX.) SKIN TONE, EYE COLOR, TEETH
 COLOR, SMELL, ACCENT, SPEECH IMPEDIMENT, CLOTHING DESCRIPTION,
 AGE, HAIR COLOR, HAIR TYPE, ANYTHING THAT STANDS OUT ETC..



AVOIDANCE TECHNIQUES

- LOCK YOUR VEHICLE AT ALL TIMES
- Park in well lit areas
- BEFORE YOU GET TO YOUR DESTINATION INSURE YOU LOCK ITEMS IN THE TRUNK
- DO NOT LEAVE THINGS IN PLAIN VIEW
- IF YOU WILL MISS IT, KEEP IT WITH YOU
- Stay off the Phone and Check Your Surroundings as you are parking and once you parked
- TRY NOT TO PARK ON SIDE STREETS AND OR IN ALLEYS
- DO NOT LEAVE WEAPONS INSIDE OF CAR IF YOU INSIST THEN GET A CAR SAFE
- AWARE OF SURROUNDINGS
