TCF Report-

Three armed robberies last weekend; two were attempted carjackings. There was another carjacking in the area (Downtown) and the car ended in Illinois. They were able to track the car/plate and victims identified one suspect for 2 of the incidents who provided information on the other four suspects. Police believe they were responsible for all of them but the victim of one incident couldn't identify the suspects. They are being held for these charges and others.

July:

3 burglaries: One burglary was in Kosciusko in which someone broke into a rental space someone runs a dog training company out of. Nothing was there to be stolen but the office was clearly disturbed. Another burglary involved a victim who reported coming home to his apartment having been broken into and guns stolen despite having recently been released from federal prison.

4 assaults: two domestic disputes, one bar fight incident, one incident outside a restaurant on 8th street.

Several larcenies and stolen vehicles. Increase in stolen golf carts.
