TCF Report-

Four robberies reported last month, 1 assault, and 3 burglaries. 28 larcenies were reported but one catalytic converter theft reported.

At 7th and Russell, the intersection was blocked off by a large group (responsible for intersection closures at 4 other locations). They use snap chat to announce the location- called Circle Club. Three individuals were shot (accidentally) at the "event." They park 4-5 cars wide and deep so you cannot get through and police would have to get out of their cars and walk.

Business Report

We received \$17,000.00 from our second disbursement.

We are still looking for a residential renter. Commissioner Clendenin's commission is expiring at the end of the year and Commissioner Dougherty will take over his Residential Owner commission. We will reach out to some renters and send something out through the Soulard Blaster and other outlets.
